**Yakima Farmers' Market 20th Anniversary
CHILI Cook off Team REQUIREMENTS/RULES
JULY 27, 2019 5:00pm - 8:00pm
Valley Mall Sears Parking Lot**

All teams are required to enter by JULY 14th, 2019, you may turn in your application at the market on or before that day or mail it in to Yakima Farmers' Market, POB 127, Yakima WA. 98907. All teams must obtain a permit from the Yakima County Health District for the event.

1. Chili must be cooked on site and a certificated kitchen is not required. All ingredients must be prepared and cooked on site.
2. There shall be no more than 4 people per team.
3. Chili ingredients must be purchased from a legitimate grocery store or butcher. Receipts must be available for the county health inspector the day of the event, cook-off.
4. All ingredients must be purchased with the intent of the chili cook-off within 7 days of this event, except for the MEAT (excluding vegetarian), which shall be 3 days of the event.
5. The use of alcohol as a ingredient is strictly prohibited.
6. Teams provide their own kitchen (pots, pans, cutting boards, knives, thermometer , and utensils including the ladles to serve with) .
7. Teams must make a minimum of (10) Ten Gallons of chili. (big 18 quart roasting pans make 4 gallons of chili) Each team may provide any condiments for their chili (chips, onions, cheese c..)
8. While cooking, teams may taste their chili, but must use a disposable spoon, and immediately dispose of it. If you are cooling your chili at a outside certified area, you must use proper cooking, cooling, transport and bring to temperature procedures as required by the Yakima County Health Department rules.
9. Chili must be prepared and kept to temperatures for judging at 5:00 pm. and on thru the event until your team is out or 7:30 pm whichever comes first.
10. Teams must provide their own extension cords (# 12 gage wire w/ground, **NO** 14 or 16 gage wire) and surge protector for each roasting pan/ crock pot used.

Each team will be provided one table for serving from. This is our 20th anniversary of the market so please decorate for it. Have fun This is a family event. MUSIC -FOOD and STREET DANCE

All chili bowls and spoons will be provided by the market.
